**RE: Lara Update re: Lara's Request for Written Copy of Magistrate Torlage's
Final Decision re: 10 May 2016 5048-15 court proceedings**

Summary of Lara & Clive discussions re: Lara 11 May request to Mag Torlage:

Lara informed Clive that Clive was entitled to inform Magistrate Torlage; via the Clerk of the Court; as to his preferences with regard to Lara request for a written copy of Magistrate Torlage's final decision re: 10 May 2016 5048-15 court proceedings.

Summary of Lara & Clive discussions re: Annex A: Questions for Clive:

Re: *Clive read documents filed by Lara.*

Clive has not clarified how much of the documents Lara filed he has read; nor whether he intends to read all the documents; and if so how much time he needs to do so.

Re: *Request clarity re Assisted Suicide Offer.*

Clive has not clarified his answer.

Re: *Mental Disorder Allegations.*

Clive stated that he had discussions with Graeme and Hillary Johnstone about withdrawing their 'mental disorder' allegations against Lara; and thought that he may enquire from them whether they would be willing to attend a meeting with Lara and Magistrate Torlage.

Lara suggested that if Clive and Ann found the meeting with Magistrate Torlage helpful; and thought a few more such meetings may be helpful to resolve issues in dispute and enable Lara, Clive and Ann could reach a clear and simple written

agreement; Clive should inform Magistrate Torlage that Clive wants to withdraw his on the record 10 May 2016 court proceedings demand that he wanted the proceedings immediately terminated. Then Clive could request another meeting with Magistrate Torlage and ask him for his suggestions and help about holding a meeting with Graeme and Hillary; if they voluntarily agree to such a meeting; and what suggestions Magistrate Torlage has for Clive; if Graeme and Hillary refuse to voluntarily agree to such a meeting; and continue to insist on their mental disorder allegations.

Graeme and Hillary were not willing to withdraw their mental disorder allegations; their current diagnosis is 'bipolar disorder'. They are worried that if Clive and Ann die; they shall be required to be financially responsible for Lara. They stated that it was Clive's fault for not taking Lara to a doctor; who could confirm their bipolar diagnosis and give Lara pills to take which would make Lara 'normal'.

Lara stated that it was not Clive's fault for not taking Lara to a doctor to give her pills to make her 'normal'.

Lara suggested that if Clive and Ann and Lara's family had been willing to support Lara with her Lentegeur damages High Court application; and she had won an amount for damages; she would have been able to use those funds to setup a Radical Honoursty Alternative Dispute Resolution small company; to provide Ecology of Peace Radical Honoursty alternative dispute resolution services to the community; and would have been quite capable of financially supporting herself; as she did while travelling the world; with a backpack for 14 years.

In such a case; neither Clive, Ann, Graeme or Hillary would ever have to bother about being financially responsible for Lara; or be required to assist Lara when she made her decision she was ready to depart the planet via Assisted Suicide in Switzerland or Russia.

Re: Barter Exchange Agreement / Taaibos House Rules:

Clive said that he had started to draw up a list of house rules; which he verbally shared with Lara. Lara said she would be willing to provide Clive with written answers to each house rule suggestion; once Clive had provided Lara with a copy in writing of his suggested or preferred Taaibos House rules.

Re: Clive not understanding particular words Lara has used.

Lara said she would happily sit down and provide Clive with verbal and written answers for every single word she has used that Clive does not understand; but it is pointless for her to sit down and clearly and simply explain her meaning for any particular word; if Clive has no intention of reading her explanation.

Timothy McVeigh and Assisted Suicide:

Lara's primary preference to survive is to be able to help Timothy McVeigh to resolve the issues that prevent him from physically spending time with Lara before they both depart this planet; together.

If or when it becomes clear that Lara and Tim shall not be able to overcome the legal obstacles that prevent them from physically spending time together; before they depart this planet; Lara's preference is to depart this planet by Switzerland Dignitas Assisted Suicide; or Russia Assisted Suicide [Annex A]; sooner than later.

If Clive and Ann don't want to provide the financial assistance for Lara's departure; Lara shall attempt to raise the funds via damages claims for her illegal Lentegeur arrest and detention; and psychological integrity damages against those who have made 'mental disorder' allegations against her. Since some of those individuals are family members; it would be helpful if Clive and Ann are prepared to confront that the legal process may result in inter-family conflict.

Summary of Lara & Clive discussions re: Annex B: EoP Acting Clerk duties suspended due to hacking of Lara computer:

Lara initially stated that she would prefer all funds not necessary for her basic survival be saved for Dignitas Assisted Suicide. However Lara changed her mind when sharing computers turned out to be a source of conflict.

Ann suggested that it was important that the computer be fixed sooner than later and Clive agreed and offered to take it in for a quote. The quote revealed that the motherboard had crashed. The technicians suggested purchasing an entirely new computer; but Lara stated that she did not require fancy bells and whistles; with the latest gadgets; only very basic programs; that allow for access to internet for research and drawing up of legal or correspondence documents. Clive generously agreed to pay for fixing it. The technicians have managed to fix the computer without resorting to adding the latest or newest hardware or software; in one case they used a second hand piece of hardware.
